Agenda Item: FY22 Grant deadline to spend funds

Background:

The FY22 grant funding must be 100% spent out by December 31st, 2024. Grant management and timely submittal of invoices is elevated in priority.

Because we are nearing the end of the grant cycle it may be beneficial to shift projects budgeted in FY24 into FY22 if they get completed prior to the end of the year. There are several projects which may not get implemented within the remaining time allowed but there are some large projects which could utilize the remaining FY22 balance and allow us to close out the grant. In order to do so, it would mean that there would be changes to partner cooperator agreements.

Fund shifts have occurred in the past. Typically, the partner's project budget does not change unless the partner agrees to forfeit the funds. Fund shifts are not an ideal option because it creates more paperwork but it might be necessary in order to utilize all of the remaining funding.

The BWSR Board Conservationist would be consulted prior to completing a shift to ensure that the goals in the work plan will still be met.

Action Requested:

Authorize the Implementation Committee to make a determination on funding shifts if it's necessary to complete them prior to the next regular meeting.

Agenda Item: Soil health funding updates

Background:

The SWCDs had requested watershed-based implementation funding in FY22 to implement non-structural best management practices on agricultural lands. No funding was requested in FY24 because there was supposed to be large amounts of state and federal grants available for these types of practices. This funding appears to be one-time funding, and allocations vary significantly between Lake of the Woods and Roseau as it is based on percentage of agricultural land.

There may be an interest in adding back non-structural ag practices into the FY26 grant work plan.

Agenda Item: Hydrology Restoration: JD 62 Wetland Banking Feasibility Study

Background:

Lake of the Woods County is following up on work that the Warroad Watershed District initiated for hydrologic restoration of parts of the Warroad Watershed. Lake of the Woods County is looking at completing a wetland banking feasibility study on the judicial ditch 62 system. Currently there are no watershed based implementation funds allocated to this effort.
